SPECIAL MEASURES:

Use water.

Avoid inhalation. Wear positive pressure self-contained breathing apparatus & protective clothing.

ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

PERSONAL PRECAUTIONS:

Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothes. Note that spillages constitute a slipping hazard. Use individual protective equipment (safety glasses, waterproof-boots, suitable protective clothing) in case of major spillages.

HANDLING & STORAGE

PRECAUTIONS IN HANDLING:

Apply good manufacturing practice & industrial hygiene practices. Observe good personal hygiene, and do not eat, drink or smoke whilst handling. Avoid static discharges.

STORAGE CONDITIONS:
